Up to and including Year 10, more than half of the subjects are taught in English.

In addition, our students get free Spanish lessons.

School equipment - A school like no other

Brains Telde facilities are the most unique on the island. During construction, they were aiming not only for a student-friendly school, but also an environmentally-friendly one.

Consequently, this building is designed based on bioclimatic architecture parameters, making the most of natural resources including sunlight, vegetation, wind and rain, always respecting native species.

In fact, Brains Telde is the only space in Gran Canaria where you can find every native species on the island.

There is has a historical heritage manor house with wooden floors and beams that turn this building into a landmark.

In contrast, a state of the art glass building with lighting control, soundproofing, high-resistance flooring, personal lockers outside every classrooms, wireless TVs and meeting points. This module is divided into classrooms, laboratories, audiovisual and multimedia room, dining room, assembly hall, and a multipurpose space.
